The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc. SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS ADMINISTERED BY THE GARDEN CLUB OF GEORGIA, INC.

PURPOSE: To provide financial aid to qualified Georgia college students majoring in any garden related subject in an accredited college or university in Georgia. College/university must be listed on the official website of the U.S. Department of Education www.ed.gov/accreditation

FUNDS: Proceeds derived from fundraising, invested interest income, and other donations as available annually continue to provide funding for scholarship grants. On average, GCG has awarded more than \$50,000 annually in scholarship grants since the 2007-2008 terms.

GRANTS: The scholarship is an annual grant for the full school year and is dispersed to the designated schools by July 15. Funds are dispersed by the school to scholarship recipients with one-half paid per semester beginning in the fall. Students are eligible to reapply for a scholarship grant as long as the student remains in good academic standing and the need is still apparent.

In the event of a change in major to other than garden related, if the student drops out of school, or moves out of the state, the balance of the funds must be returned to The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc.

JUDGING: The selection of scholarship winners is made by the Scholarship Committee of The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc., and is based on the following criteria:

Academic Record (40%) Transcript of grades required. An original hard copy is necessary. Emphasis

placed on the strength of courses related to students' major in horticulture or

allied field.

Applicant's Letter (25%) Discussion of background, goals, personal commitment to chosen career, and

financial need should be included. Please limit to two (2) typewritten pages.

Print one-sided, only.

Financial Need (15%) UGA students use athena.uga.edu to view and print your financial aid and award

> information in addition to completing the Financial Aid form. Other schools may have a similar portal to obtain financial aid information. Your OSFA advisor will accept the GCG form if you have submitted a Scholarship Consent

to Release Information to OSFA. This form must be completed and

submitted with your application.

List of Honors, and Work Experience (13%)

Extra-Curricular Activities This information should be supplied on a separate sheet of paper and not listed within the body of the applicant's personal statement. Three years is sufficient.

Recommendations (5%) Two (2) letters of recommendation, each limited to one (1) typewritten

> page are required. Please date letters prior to February 1. References must use "Dear Scholarship Committee" or "To Whom It May Concern" in the salutation rather than to The Garden Club of Georgia. A more generic letter and NOT referencing The Garden Club of Georgia anywhere in the letter will allow the student's application, if selected, prompt submission

to The National Garden Clubs, Inc. for scholarship consideration.

Conformance (2%) Points deducted from the application if instructions are not followed or arrives late.

GUIDELINES FOR ADMINISTERING THE GARDEN CLUB OF GEORGIA, INC. SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS

Scholarship Policy of The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc.

- 1. All profits derived from fundraising efforts continue to provide academic scholarships to qualified Georgia college students majoring in any garden related subject in an accredited college or university in Georgia. College/university must be listed on the official website of the U.S. Department of Education www.ed.gov/accreditation
 - Judging of recipients for the scholarships is based on academic record, applicant's letter, financial need, honors, extra-curricular activities, work experience, and recommendations. The Scholarship Committee of The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc. makes the selection of scholarship winners.
- 2. Applicants must be majoring in Agriculture Education, Horticulture, Floriculture, Landscape Design, Botany, Plant Biology, Plant Pathology, Plant Sciences, Forestry, Agronomy, Environmental Concerns, Environmental Conservation, Urban and Rural Planning, Wildlife Science Habitat, Forest Systems, Ecology, Land Management, and/or other garden related or allied subjects. See separate guidelines and application forms for the Cherokee Rose Scholarship.
- 3. The monies to cover the scholarship grants are sent to the Bursar's Office of the University of Georgia, Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College or other designated school's Financial Aid Office for disbursement no later than July 15. The academic scholarship is an annual grant for the full school year. Funds should be dispersed as follows: One-half of the amounts are paid per semester.
- 4. In the event of a change to a non-garden related major, or if the student drops out of school or moves out of the state, the balance of the funds must be returned to The Garden Club of Georgia, Inc., 2450 South Milledge Avenue, Athens, GA 30605-1674, 706-227-5369
- 5. Applicant must be a U.S. Citizen residing in the state of Georgia for the past four years paying in-state tuition and must be enrolled at an accredited college or university. Documentation of acceptance or enrollment at an accredited college must be provided.
- 6. Applications received after February 1st will have points deducted.
- 7. Equal Opportunity shall be provided to all applicants, within the guidelines as stated in the application criteria.



APPLICANTS: Scholarships are available to students who are U.S. citizens and who have been residents of Georgia for the past four years and are paying in-state tuition.

Recipients must be full-time students majoring in Agriculture Education, Horticulture, Floriculture, Landscape Design, Botany, Plant Biology, Plant Pathology, Plant Sciences, Forestry, Agronomy, Environmental Concerns, Environmental Conservation, Urban and Rural Planning, Wildlife Science Habitat, Forest Systems, Ecology, Land Management, and/or other garden related or allied subjects at an accredited college or university in Georgia.

An exception is the *Cherokee Rose Scholarship*, which is available only to full-time graduate students, U. S. Citizens, residents of Georgia for the past four years, majoring in programs of Decorative Arts, Environmental Planning and Design, Historic Architecture, Historic Preservation, or Landscape Architecture at an accredited college or university in Georgia. APPLICATIONS: Only typed Scholarship Applications considered. Please do not staple. Include the following:

- 1. **Official transcript** of academic record, which includes the latest grading period and minimum overall averages.
- 2. Financial Aid and Award documents from athena.uga.edu (UGA students) or similar portals from other schools. You <u>must</u> complete the GCG financial aid form below and have your OSFA advisor sign it. You will need to complete and submit to the OSFA a Scholarship Consent to Release Information.
- 3. Names of two (2) references as indicated on the form. Supporting one-page letters may be sent directly to the Scholarship Committee at the below address. See Recommendations under Judging on page 2 for additional requirements.
- 4. Extracurricular Activities List as indicated on the form.
- 5. Applicant's written statement discussing goals, background, and reasons for scholarship application.
- 6. Applications must be received typed and printed <u>single-sided only</u>.

DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 1. Completed applications must be sent to the Scholarship Committee on or before the deadline. Applications received after February 1st.
