Directions to The Pope Center, South Georgia Technical College 900 South GA Tech Parkway Americus, GA 31709

The meeting will be held in the Pope Center. When your reach the college, traveling east on South Georgia Parkway turn right onto Lindberg /Career Drive. Jet at entrance. Traveling west on SGT Parkway turn left onto Lindbergh. Jet at entrance. The Pope Center is the south right building. Turn right onto Technology to access Pope Center's north parking area. Pope Center is on south side of North parking area. Additional parking: You may continue straight on Lindberg, then turn right onto Transportation. Continue by turning right into second drive to access west parking area and west entrance to Pope Building. Note map.

Traveling from Georgia Highway 27 or U.S. 280 East

Go to the traffic light at the Intersection of Georgia Highway 49 North. There is a Flash Foods gas station and a Wendy's restaurant at that intersection. Turn right onto Highway 49 and proceed four-and-a-half (4 1/2) miles Northeast. You will see a South Georgia Technical College sign with a Jet. Continue left at the roundabout onto South Georgia Tech Parkway and go one and-a-half (1 1/2) miles to South Georgia Technical College.

Traveling from Highway 19 South, 280 West or 49 South

These three highways will merge together at the intersection of U.S. Highway 19 and U.S. Highway 280. From there, continue North on U.S. Highway 19 for 3.8 miles. Turn right on South Georgia Tech Parkway and continue for 3.5 miles. South Georgia Technical College will be on the right.

Traveling from Highway 30 West

Turn left when Georgia Highway 30 intersects with U.S. Highway 19. Go north for 2.0 miles, and then turn right at South Georgia Tech Parkway and continue for 3.5 miles. South Georgia Technical College will be on the right.


Traveling from Highway 19 North

Approximately 10 miles south of Ellaville, turn left onto South Georgia Tech Parkway (there will be a sign with a jet) and continue for 3.5 miles. South Georgia Technical College will be on the right.

Traveling from Highway 49 North

Six-and-a-half (6 1/2) miles from Andersonville National Cemetery, you will see a South Georgia Technical College sign with a Jet at the roundabout. Turn right onto South Georgia Technical College is on your left in approximately one-and-a-half (1 1/2) miles.
