Join us for an exciting tour of beautiful Newport, RI. Founded in 1639, Newport is said to be one of the most important port cities in the 18th century North American British colonies. In addition to its colonial past, Newport is known for its rich sailing history, its magnificent coastal scenery, and its opulent gilded age "summer cottages".

ITINERARY

Tuesday, June 18:

We begin our tour at the TF Green airport in Providence, RI where our coach will meet pick us up at 12:30PM.*

As we make our way to Newport, we will enjoy an included lunch and visit the Green Animals Topiary Garden, the oldest and most northern topiary garden in the United States. Green Animals has 80 sculptured trees and shrubs including 21 delightful animal shapes. Other highlights include the Brayton House, formal flower beds, fruit and vegetable gardens, and beautiful views of Narragansett Bay.

In the late afternoon we will check into the beautiful Brenton Hotel. Newport's newest luxury boutique waterfront hotel is ideally situated within walking distance of numerous restaurants and shopping.

Dinner is on your own evening.

There are numerous alternative flights for those who may wish to arrive earlier or leave later; and driving to Rhode Island is another great option. It is also possible to arrive or depart by train!

Wednesday, June 19:

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then set out for a guided tour of Newport on our private trolley.

The Gilded Age comes alive as you tour Newport and hear all about the lives of the rich and famous of Newport's high society of the 1800s. Enter the world of Vanderbilts, Astors, and the wealthiest of Gilded Age tycoons as you travel Newport's fabulous Bellevue Avenue, peppered with stunning mansions and gardens. Take in the rugged beauty of Ten-Mile Ocean Drive featuring magnificent ocean views and historic Fort Adams.

Following the tour, we head to the Breakers Mansion for a self-guided tour. The Breakers is the grandest of Newport's summer "cottages" and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family's social and financial status. The Breakers was built by Cornelius Vanderbilt II and was everything a millionaire of the Gilded Age could want in a summer getaway. A classic Italian palazzo design, the finest American and Italian craftsmanship, views of the sea, and modern technology combined to make the ideal setting for luxurious living and entertaining.

Lunchtime brings us to the Tea House located on the Marble House property for an included tea (light lunch) featuring pastries, savories, tea sandwiches, and sweets. After tea, we tour Marble House, the summer "cottage" of Mr. and Mrs. William K. Vanderbilt. The house was designed by architect Richard Morris Hunt who designed Biltmore House in Asheville, NC. Its design was inspired by the Petit Trianon at Versailles, and, according to reports in the contemporary press, cost about \$11 million, of which \$7 million was spent on 500,000 cubic feet of marble.

Later in the afternoon, we will sail around Newport Harbor and Narragansett Bay aboard a classic schooner. As we sip mimosas, we will view the magnificent, gilded age mansions, the Newport Yacht Club, Jacqueline Kennedy's summer home, the towering Newport Bridge, the Rock House, and more. Dinner this evening is on your own as you enjoy exploring the area.

Meals – Breakfast, Tea

Thursday, June 20:

After a leisurely breakfast, a private trolley will arrive to whisk us off to the Blue Garden. As we tour the garden, we will learn about its history and restorations. After the tour, there will be some free time to explore the garden on your own before our included lunch.

This afternoon, our first stop is Rough Point the home of the heiress Doris Duke for a tour of the beautiful home and special exhibits. Later we will tour the historically significent Blithewold Estate with its mansion, grand views of Narragansett Bay, gardens, and arboretum.

This evening we gather for a farewell dinner.
